- Sunday, July 27** Opening Ceremonies: Beginning at 4:00PM at the I-Wireless Center, 1201 River Drive, Moline. The I-Wireless Center is an indoor 12,000 seat civic center where minor league sporting events, as well as concerts and events are held. Team entertainment, including food, will be provided immediately following opening ceremonies.
- Monday, July 27**
Tuesday, July 28 Pool Play: Beginning at 8:00AM. All pool play will be scheduled for Monday and Tuesday at the Greenvalley and Campbell Complexes. Teams will be scheduled for one pool play game per day. Gift exchange for teams will be at the first pool play game of the tournament for each team.

I. Timetable

This will help to prevent last minute problems. ***IF YOU CANNOT MAIL BEFORE THE DEADLINE, PLEASE HAND CARRY OFFICIAL ROSTER AND BE SURE IT IS SIGNED BY YOUR ASSOCIATION COMMISSIONER.***

- B. **Team Check-In** – Saturday, July 26, from 5:00PM – 8:00PM at the I-Wireless Center, 1201 River Drive, Moline or Sunday, July 27, from 8:00AM – 12:00PM at the I-Wireless Center. (Verification of rosters, rain procedure forms, practice schedule, advance ticket sales, souvenir sales.) All players must be present at check-in. Player picture identification required.
- C. **Managers' Lunch** – Sunday, July 27 at 12:30PM at the I-Wireless Center, 1201 River Drive, Moline. This is a mandatory meeting for team managers. *One manager representing each team will be admitted free-of-charge.* Others wishing to attend the luncheon must purchase tickets in advance (order form enclosed). The charge for additional luncheon tickets is \$12.00 per person. Limited space is available.
- D. **Pool Play and Bracket Play Draws** – Both the pool play and bracket play draws will be competed pre-tournament per Article 511 of the ASA Code. Pool play draw will be held Tuesday, July 22 at 1:30PM at the Moline Park Office, 3635 4th Avenue, Moline, with bracket play draw immediately following. Hard copies of the results will be distributed at the Managers' Lunch.
- E. **Opening Ceremonies** – Sunday, July 27, beginning at 4:00PM at the I-Wireless Center, 1201 River Drive, Moline. All teams are requested to participate. Please be in full uniform. Team entertainment, including food, will be provided immediately following opening ceremonies.
- F. **Pool Play** - Pool play will be held on Monday, July 28 and Tuesday, July 29, beginning at 8:00AM at the Greenvalley and Campbell Complexes. Each team will play one pool play game per day.
- G. **Team Pictures** – Team pictures will be scheduled beginning Monday, July 28, 10:00AM at the Greenvalley Sports Complex and continue through Tuesday, July 29, 5:00PM.
- H. **Double-Elimination Tournament** - The double-elimination portion of the tournament will begin on Wednesday, July 30, 2007.

II. Rules and Regulations

- A. All playing rules and regulations will be governed by the 2008 ASA Official Guide and Rule Book.
- B. A run rule of fifteen after three and eight after five full innings will apply (ASA Rule 5, Section 9). A time limit of 1 hour, 40 minutes will be in effect for all pool games (ASA Rule 5, Section 10).
- C. Dress Code:
 - 1. Uniforms
 - a. Players on a team shall properly wear uniforms that are alike in color, trim and style (ASA Official Playing Rules, Rule 3, Section 6 and 7 A-G).
 - b. Coaches must be neatly attired, dressed alike or in team uniform, and in accordance with the color code of the team.

II. Awards

- A. Team trophies – First, Second, Third, Fourth and two Fifth places.
- B. Individual Awards – First, Second, Third and Fourth place.
- C. See National Awards, Article 607, page 106, for additional award information.

III. Tournament Draw

- A. Games will be scheduled in a pool play format to begin the tournament. Both pool play and bracket play draws will be completed pre-tournament per Article 511 of the ASA Code. Hard copies of the results will be distributed at the Managers' Lunch. Each team will be scheduled to play a minimum of four games.

IV. General Information

- A. **Format** – Two (2) pool games followed by double elimination tournament.
- B. **Line-Up-Cards** – Tournament officials will provide the line-up cards for each team. An official card must be submitted to the scorekeeper at least 15-minutes prior to game time.
- C. **Game Times** – Follow the times listed on the official tournament bracket. Game time is forfeit time. Teams should be prepared to play immediately after the preceding game is completed.

- D. **Infield Practice** – No infield practice will be permitted. Warm-up is allowed in designated areas only. Teams may warm up on the outfield grass if time permits. Teams wishing to practice may reserve a practice field by calling (309) 736-5714 between the hours of 7:00AM and 4:00PM CST.
- E. **Protests** – The Tournament Committee will decide all protests. As manager, please be familiar with the rules of the game, including proper protest procedures (ASA Rule 9).
- F. **Inclement Weather** – In the event of inclement weather, the game must be resumed at the exact point where it was suspended. It is the manager's responsibility to report to the information hotline, or visit the tournament headquarters at the Greenvalley Sports Complex for rescheduling information.

In the event the tournament cannot be completed within the scheduled time frame, and more than 40% of the scheduled games have been completed, the official order of finish will be determined in accordance with Article 510, General Regulations of Championship Play, Section J2 Procedure.

- G. **Home Team** – a coin-toss prior to the start of each game shall determine the home team.
- H. **Dugouts** – The team at the top of the bracket will use the first-base dugout. The team at the bottom of the bracket will use the third-base dugout.
- I. **Official Game Ball** – The official ball for the tournament has been provided by Worth Sports Company. All softballs must be approved by the ASA Executive Director in accordance with Rule 3, Section 3, The Official Ball.
- J. **Conduct** – Managers and coaches are asked to have complete control of their players both on and off the field. Any report of damage by hotel management will be dealt with by the Tournament Committee in accordance with Article 510, General Regulations of Championship Play, Section M, Team Conduct.
- K. **Souvenirs** – Souvenirs will be available at the Greenvalley and Campbell Sports Complexes throughout the week. T-Shirts, hats, shorts, sweatshirts, and other memorabilia will be available.
- L. **Food, Pets, Alcohol, Smoking** – Only water coolers may be brought into the sports complexes. Food items must not leave the parking areas. Pets and alcoholic beverages are not allowed in the sports complexes. Smoking is permitted only in the designated parking areas of Greenvalley Park.
